Chapter Achievement Awards

Chapter achievements are given to AFWA chapters that have achieved excellence in membership, communications, programming, scholarship, and public service.



Membership: This award recognizes chapters that have excelled in their membership recruitment and retention efforts.

Communications: This award recognizes outstanding and unique communication efforts of a chapter.

Programming: This award shall be awarded based on outstanding programming efforts that enhance the value of membership and improve member engagement.

Scholarship: This award recognizes outstanding chapter scholarship programming. Programming includes fundraising efforts, membership recruitment, diversity and inclusion efforts, and over-all scholarship dollars awarded.

Public Service: This award shall be awarded based on the chapter's involvement in their community and their public service efforts. The award can also recognize an individual program within a chapter's community.
